Poultry (with the exception of doves, pigeons & waterfowl) must be accompanied by: **1)** results of a negative Pullorum-typhoid test conducted within 90 days prior to exhibition OR **2)** proof that the birds originate directly from a US Pullorum-typhoid clean flock or equivalent flock. U.S. Pullorum-typhoid clean or equivalent testing must be within 2 yrs. of exhibition.

Pullorum testing will be conducted at the Fairgrounds in the Hall of Agriculture on Tuesday, June 28 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm.

Rules and Regulations

1. Before making entries read standards for conduct of Fair and General Rules and Regulations of the Schoharie County Sunshine Fair.
2. All birds exhibited at the fair shall be biologically isolated from the flock (no direct or indirect contact) for at least two weeks after returning to the premise of origin.
3. All birds should be moved to and from the fair in clean, disinfected crates and trunks.
4. All possible precaution should be used to prevent tracking disease agents from exhibit to other premises.
5. All entries will be entered by breed and variety.
6. A limit of two (2) entries in any one class may be made by one exhibitor.
7. All exhibits must be on the grounds by 9:00 am the day of the show. Exhibitors will provide their own cages.
8. A trio shall consist of 1 male & 2 female and may not be entered as single entries in this department.
9. Only chickens can exhibit as trios.
10. Birds must be of acceptable age and condition or the superintendent will reject the entry.
11. All birds will be cared for by the exhibitors.
12. Exhibitors should be present for the judging in this Department.
13. Single exhibitors in a class shall receive second award unless the Judge deems the exhibit outstanding.
14. All chickens, ducks, turkeys, and geese will be judged according to Standards of Perfection.
15. **ENTRY FEE IS DOUBLED FOR BIRDS ENTERED ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW.**
