Rules and Regulations

- 1 Before making entries read standards for conduct of Fairs and General rules and regulations of the Schoharie County Sunshine Fair.
- 2 **PLEASE SEE PAGE 1 OF THE PREMIUM BOOK FOR TICKET FEES. TWO PEOPLE PER HORSE WILL BE ADMITTED FREE OF CHARGE IF ENTERING THE DAY OF THE SHOW.**
- 3 Per New York State Law No. VAT1265, all riders' 13 years of age and under must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) equestrian standard. The parent/guardian who signs the release form for an exhibitor 13 and under is personally responsible for seeing that those exhibitor(s) in their care, custody and control obey this law.
- 4 All entries must be accompanied by proof of rabies inoculation and negative coggins test. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 5 Competition is open to all persons. Open to horses and ponies 13.3 hands or 55 inches and over. Ponies under 13.3 hands or 55 inches and under, can enter classes 1, 3, 20, 22, 24, 25, 27, 29, 30, 31, 34, & 38.
- 6 A limited number of stalls will be available to rent at \$12.00 per day. Stall reservations must be received with payment by June 10, 2011. You will be mailed a receipt. Stalls will be available on a first-come, first served basis. Daily reservations are from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. unless otherwise specified at the time of reservation. Only stalls rented for more than one day will be occupied after 8 p.m. When making reservations, please state the number of stalls needed and the days they will be used. **No bedding will be provided by the Fair.**
- 7 **Off-line Pre-entries must be post marked by June 10, 2011 and on-line Pre-Entries must be made by June 17, 2011. After these dates entries must be made on the day of the show.** Entries taken at 7 AM day of the Show.
- 8 Judging starts at 8:30 a.m. Exhibitors to wear appropriate Western apparel and tack. (Except for Costume Class)
- 9 Course Patterns will be posted the morning of the Show.
- 10 Bosal - No mechanical or steel hackamores.
- 11 Snaffle Bit - Dee or O Ring snaffle; no shanks. Rider to use two hands. No nose bands or tie downs, head gear to be checked at the start of class.
- 12 Some classes are listed specifically for Juniors with cash prizes totaling \$52 offered.
- 13 The Adult walk jog division is for adults only, 18 years of age and older. Walk/jog trot only and for novice and beginner riders only. **Riders not to cross over into other divisions.** (These classes are not for schooling or training.)
