**Deadline for off-line pre-entries is June 10th, 2011. Deadline for on-line pre-entries is June 17th, 2011.
All people staying for the week should be entered by this date. All other Entries will be taken the day of the show.**

Rules and Regulations

1. Before making entries read standards for conduct of Fairs and general rules and regulations of Cobleskill Fair. **Exhibitors' 18 years and older bringing donkeys or mules to stay for the week must purchase an Exhibitor Ticket for \$20. Exhibitors 17 years and younger must purchase a Jr. Exhibitor Ticket for \$10. Exhibitors staying for the Fair may purchase up to 9 daily tickets at \$6. each. Exhibitors entering the day of the show will be admitted at no charge for two people per horse.**

2. **All entries must be accompanied by proof of rabies inoculation and negative coggins test. Entries will not be completed if rabies and coggins test are not with entries. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

3. Per New York State Law No VAT1265, all riders' 13 years of age and under must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) equestrian standard. The parent/guardian who signs the release form for an exhibitor 13 and under is personally responsible for seeing that those exhibitor(s) in their care, custody and control obey this law.

4. Early entries are greatly appreciated; however, you may post enter after 7:00 a.m. on Saturday until 8:00 a.m. at no additional fee for Halter classes.

5. Donkey and Mule exhibitors are invited to participate in the Draft Horse exhibit. Animals will be accepted until the limited capacity of the barn is filled. All inquiries concerning the Mule and Donkey show should be referred to Sandi Emanuel, Richmondville, NY. **All exhibitors staying in the barn for the fair must be pre-entered. Pre-entries will be accepted until June 17th. After that date all entries must be made the day of the show.**

6. Best of show to be selected from 1st and 2nd place equines in following categories: Mini Donkey, Standard Donkey, Mammoth Donkey and Mule/Hybrid.

7. Coon Jumping is over an increasingly higher jump, from a standstill in a defined area. Walking, trotting, cantering and galloping towards the jump **NOT** allowed.

8. The obstacle classes will include bridges, gateways, cross rails, pole bending, tarps, and a few surprises you might just encounter on a trail ride. An equine may be entered either in-hand or under saddle, **but not both.**

10. Draft Horse Barn exhibitors will be provided with free stalls Thursday evening. **Please list the number of stalls needed on entry blank. Shavings will be made available at the beginning of the Fair for initial bedding of stalls by draft horse barn exhibitors staying the week only. Any additional bedding must be provided by exhibitors. There will be no concession on the grounds this year from which to purchase bedding, it will have to be brought in by the exhibitor(s). NO bedding will be furnished by the fair.**

11. Halter classes will be judged Saturday morning starting at 8:00 a.m. in the judging ring in the infield. All Hitch classes will be judged on Saturday beginning right after halter classes in the infield ring.

12. At no time will Donkeys and Mules be allowed to be driven on any vehicle in areas of the fairgrounds where the fair management has not previously granted permission to do so.

13. The Fair Director or Management may deny admission to, or require segregation of or removal from Fair premises, any animal found to be infected with or exposed to any communicable disease whether internal or external, and whether or not such disease is specifically mentioned in these regulations, if in his opinion such action is necessary for the protection of other exhibits. Any animal disqualified for participation in the Fair should be removed from the grounds by the end of the same day.

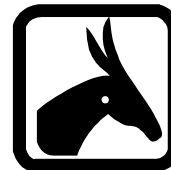
14. The Draft Barn Superintendent will make all stall assignments in the barn and his decision is final.

15. All draft animals must be washed at the designated area. **NO** animals shall be washed in front of the draft horse barn by the hydrant. Failure to obey this rule will forfeit the premium.
