Rules and Regulations

1. Before making entries read standards for conduct of Fairs and General rules and regulations of the Schoharie County Sunshine Fair.
2. **Please see page 1 of the premium book for ticket fees. Two people per horse will be admitted free of charge if entering the day of the show.**
3. All entries must be accompanied by proof of rabies inoculation and negative coggins test. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Horses brought to the fairgrounds will not be admitted to the grounds unless the exhibitor has the necessary record of immunodiffusion (coggins) test or has previously submitted their entry sheets to the fair office. In sending entries, record or Photostat of immunodiffusion (coggins) test and rabies inoculation should accompany entry blank.
4. Per New York State Law No. VAT1265, all riders' 13 years of age and under must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) equestrian standard. The parent/guardian who signs the release form for an exhibitor 13 and under is personally responsible for seeing that those exhibitor(s) in their care, custody and control obey this law.
5. Fair Management reserves the right to combine or eliminate any class because of insufficient entries.
6. The show will follow USEF Rules.
7. Ponies are welcome and encouraged to enter the children's hunter section, and any other class for which the exhibitor feels they qualify.
8. Additional classes for ponies are listed in Section 9.
9. Junior drivers must be accompanied by an adult capable of driving and must also wear an ASTM approved helmet at all times while driving or riding as a passenger with an adult driver. Any junior without the approved headgear must be eliminated from the class.
10. **Off-line Pre entries must be received with payment by June 10, 2011, or on-line Pre-entries must be received by June 17, 2011. After these dates entries must be made the day of the show.**
11. Entries will be accepted starting at 7:30 a.m. on show day. Entries must be made no later than one class prior to class being entered.
12. At least three (3) horses must be entered in a Division in order for the Champion and Reserve Championships to be awarded.
13. A limited number of stalls will be available to rent at \$12.00 per day. Camper hook-ups are available at \$20.00 per night. **All stall reservations must be received with payment by June 17th**; you will be mailed a receipt that must be presented before receiving your stall assignment. Daily reservations are from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. unless otherwise specified at the time of reservation. Only stalls rented for more than one day will be occupied after 8:00 p.m. When making reservations, please state the number of stalls needed, and the days they will be used. **NO BEDDING WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE FAIR.**
14. Juniors are offered cash prizes totaling \$200 in the English Show.

41 Lite Shod Plantation Pleasure To be shown at a flat walk, running walk and canter. A noticeable increase in speed between the flat walk and the running walk is required. They are to back readily and stand quietly in line. Judged 20% flat walk, 40% running walk, 20% canter and 20% conformation. English or Western tack and attire are permitted.

42 Lite Shod Pleasure Horse - Horses to enter the ring at a running walk. To be shown at the flat walk, running walk and canter, both ways of the ring. There should be a noticeable increase in speed between the flat walk and running walk. Horses must back and stand quietly in line. English or Western tack and attire are permitted.

43 Lite Shod Trail Pleasure - Two Gaited To be shown at a flat walk and running walk (no canter). To be judged on manners and apparent ability to give long distance pleasure ride.

44 Mint Julep Each rider takes rail with filled glass at the flat walk. The class is worked both ways at flat walk and running walk. When parked, each glass is measured for placing. In case of ties, these riders will take the rail with remaining liquid. They will canter both ways. Liquid will be measured again for winner.

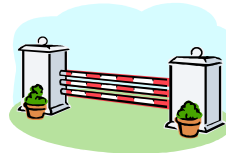
45 Lite Shod All Day Pleasure To be shown at a flat walk and running walk (no canter). To be judged on manners and apparent ability to give long distance pleasure ride.

46 Plantation Pleasure Stake Horses must have shown in Class 41, Class 42, and 45. To be judged the same as Lite Shod Plantation Pleasure.
