Rules and Regulations

1. Before making entries read standards for conduct of Fairs and General rules and regulations of Cobleskill Fair.
2. TWO PEOPLE PER HORSE WILL BE ADMITTED FREE OF CHARGE IF ENTERING THE DAY OF THE SHOW. All others must pay admittance fees.
3. ONE ENTRY FORM FOR EACH DEPARTMENT AND ALSO EXHIBITOR/HORSE COMBINATION.
4. All entries must be accompanied by proof of rabies inoculation and negative coggins test. NO EXCEPTIONS.
5. Per New York State Law No. VAT1265, all riders' 17 years of age and under must wear a helmet meeting or exceeding ASTM F1163 (Safety Equipment Institute Certified) equestrian standard. The parent/guardian who signs the release form for an exhibitor 17 and under is personally responsible for seeing that those exhibitor(s) in their care, custody and control obey this law. Junior drivers must also wear an ASTM approved helmet at all times while driving or riding as a passenger with an adult driver. Any junior without the approved headgear must be eliminated from the class. Juniors are 17 & Under.
6. Nominate yourself and your horse for the Sunshine Show Series Awards. Go to the sunshine fair.org or ssshowseries.com for a nomination form and mail it in or hand in before the show starts.
7. Pointed by the Sunshine Show Series and go by Sunshine Show Series Rules
8. Pre-entries must be made by July 6. After July 6 entries must be made the day of the show.
9. Late fee of \$10 per horse if not pre-entered.
10. Breaking gate will be cause for a disqualification. No cantering in driving classes.
11. Post entries for classes will be accepted the day of the show.
12. No Exhibitors or animals may enter the grounds before 7 p.m. the day before the show. A limited number of stalls will be available to rent at \$12.00 per day. Stalls will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Daily reservations are from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. unless otherwise specified at the time of reservation. Only stalls rented for more than one day will be occupied after 8 p.m. When making reservations, please state the number of stalls needed, and the days they will be used. No bedding will be furnished by the Fair.
13. Bosals-No mechanical or steel hackamores.
14. Exhibitors to wear appropriate apparel and tack according to Sunshine Show rules.
15. Management reserves the right to combine cancel classes.
16. Rescue Equine Division: Open to horses, ponies, or mules/donkeys who have been adopted from rescue organizations, purchased from kill buyers to prevent them from going to slaughter, former race horses starting a second career or similar situations. Entries must be able to show proof they are qualified to show management. Examples: copy of adoption paperwork, reclassification of registration papers (Non racing for Standardbreds) bill of sale from Moore's Equine Rescue(kill buyer) etc. Purpose of this class is to reward exhibitors for taking time to give equines a second chance to thrive and to shed light on the need of formally unwanted equines.
17. Showmanship Challenge- Year End Award is a buckle- must nominate to participate
18. Starter classes are for horses/ponies that do not canter and may not enter any canter classes at any competition or exhibition. Horses/ponies may enter this division for as long as they do not canter or lope at any competition or exhibition.

The parent/guardian who signs the release form for an exhibitor 17 years of age and under is personally responsible for seeing that those exhibitor(s) in their care, custody, and control obey this law.

The undersigned promises to exhibit at the Schoharie County Sunshine Fair the horses named and does hereby certify that said hereinafter mentioned horses, so proposed to be exhibited, is hereby entered for exhibition in accordance with the Rules and Regulations contained in the Cobleskill Agricultural Society Premium Book and by which the undersigned hereby agrees to be governed in exhibiting the same. The exhibitor agrees to be solely responsible for any loss or injury to or damage done, occasioned by, or arising from any animal, equipment, exhibit, or person on exhibition, and to defend and indemnify the Cobleskill Fair and the management thereof against all claims and liability in regard thereto, and upon these conditions only will entries be accepted. In view of the indemnity agreement appearing herein, exhibitors may find it advisable for their own protection to carry liability insurance if not covered. Exhibitor agrees to abide by the rules of the Cobleskill Agricultural Society.
