General Rules and Regulations

1. Before making entries read "Standards of Conduct of Fairs" and "Livestock Requirements".
- 2. All goats must be vaccinated against rabies following the same protocol as for other species.**
- 3. The open goat shows will not be NGA pointed show. Animals exhibited in the open show must arrive on Sunday/Monday prior to the fair start and will be released on the last day of the fair. Please see below for arrival, discharge and vet inspection rules.**
4. Before making entries read "Rules and Regulations" pertaining to goats.
5. Entries should be received by July 3rd, unless specified otherwise. The address is Cobleskill Agricultural Society, PO Box 249, Cobleskill NY 12043.
6. Entry fee is 10% of first premiums or \$7 minimum for all entries, except where noted differently.
7. Late entries, where accepted, will be accepted thru July 10 at an additional charge of \$10.
- 8. Exhibits will be received August 8th & 9th between 9 am and 1 pm. All animals will have a health check before removal from transport vehicle.**
9. Vehicles and trailers will be allowed in the area for loading and unloading only; they must be parked in designated areas.
10. Youth exhibitors are encouraged to show in open classes.
- 11. Exhibits will be released 7 p.m. on Sunday, August 15th and must be off the grounds by noon Monday following the fair's end, unless specified differently. Due to the release time and other activities on the grounds, extra measures have been taken to insure that safety and traffic patterns are not impacted in any negative way. Exhibits leaving before the permitted time will forfeit their premium money.**
12. Age of all animals in this department will be computed from date of birth to the day of show.
13. Each exhibitor will supply his/her own feed and bedding. Limited pens are available on a first come, first served basis. Exhibitors are responsible for cleanup of their area.
14. Not over two premiums shall be awarded to any one exhibitor in any one class. Ribbons shall be awarded as judged.
15. All animals shown in group or special classes must have been shown in their regular age or category class.
16. Check of entries, classes and registration papers will occur before the show starts.
17. Please indicate on entry form the total number of animals entered for exhibition in this department and the number of pens needed.
18. All goats must have a permanent form of identification that coincides with both veterinarian inspection certificate and registration papers (if applicable).
19. All females that show must have kidded at least once since turning 24 months of age.

SECTIONS 37-46 – REGISTERED DAIRY GOATS

Dairy Goat Rules and Regulations (in addition to General Rules & Regulations):

- All animals will be ADGA, AGS or CGS registered and have their registration/recording paperwork. If under 6 months of age, a stamped duplicate of the registration application is acceptable. Additionally, tattoos must be legible and correlate with the registration paperwork. There will be no pre-show milk out. Overly distended udders will be discriminated against.
- Milk is to be disposed of in area noted by the superintendent.
- NO HORNS** on dairy animals.
- No refunds after entries close; substitutions are allowed with breed section at no extra fee.
- Judging is scheduled for 8 a.m. on Saturday for dairy goats in the Sheep/Goat area.
- The show will start with showmanship.

The Meat and Fiber Goat Show is not sanctioned by any goat registry.

Meat & Fiber Goat Rules & Regulations (in addition to General Rules & Regulations):

- Horns are allowed, no discrimination for dehorned animals.
- No bucks will be shown, including the meat classes.
- All animals in sections 47 & 48 will be registered and have their registration paperwork. If under 6 months of age, a stamped duplicate of the registration application is acceptable. These animals must be tattooed, Scrapie tagged or microchipped (bring your own reader) according to the official USDA Scrapie program guidelines. Animals in Section 49 & 50 must be properly identified according to the USDA Scrapie program guidelines (tag).
- Senior animals must have kidded at least once.
- Market goats can only show in market classes; they are ineligible to show as breeding stock.
- No refunds after entries close; substitutions are allowed within breed section at no extra fee.

1. Entries must be received by July 3. Mailing/payee is Cobleskill Agricultural Society, PO Box 249, Cobleskill, NY 12043.
2. Late entries, where accepted, will be accepted thru July 10 at an additional charge \$10
3. In accordance with the bylaws of the Cobleskill Agricultural Society, Schoharie County resident exhibitors 18 years of age or older have the option to purchase a \$55 6-Day Voting Membership Pass in lieu of the \$20 6-Day Exhibitor Pass.
4. One Guardian Pass per youth exhibitor is available for an adult to accompany the youth. The price for a 6-day Guardian Pass is \$20. Not to be combined with other entry forms.

5. All entry fees will be computed and paid on this form. Entries will be made on the appropriate entry form. No premium entry fee for Dept. 11.
6. ALL open livestock exhibitors staying for the entire 6 days of the Fair are entitled to two (2) free Passes. **Exhibitors are still required to purchase tickets as required by entry.** Not to be combined with other entry forms. Tickets will not be issued unless names are provided below:

7. No tickets will be mailed. All tickets will be distributed by the Department Superintendents upon receipt (placement) of entries.
8. No exhibitor tickets, guardian pass, or free exhibitor passes will be distributed unless entered exhibits are brought to the fair.
9. Submission of an entry implies the exhibitor has read and agrees to the Fair's General Rules and Regulations and the Department's Rules and Regulation.
