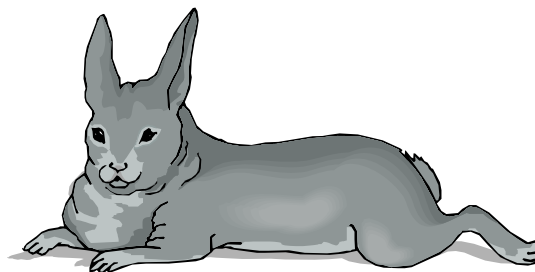
Rules and Regulations

1. This department will accept entries from exhibitors who reside in Schoharie or a contiguous county.
 2. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Maximum number of entries to be accepted in all sections of this department will be determined by the number of cages available. No exceptions will be made. Rabbits will be received August 8th & 9th from 9 am to 1 pm. **Animals will be health checked as they arrive before they are removed from vehicles and can be denied entry if they are not found in healthy condition.** They must be clean with clipped nails. All animals must have permanent ear tattoo. Any animal disqualified for participation in the Fair should be removed from the grounds by the end of the same day. **Please provide your own water and feed dishes. Exhibitors will be responsible for the feeding, watering and care of their animals.**
 3. Entries should be received by July 3rd, unless specified otherwise. The address is Cobleskill Agricultural Society, PO Box 249, Cobleskill NY 12043.
 4. Late entries, where accepted, will be accepted thru July 10 at an additional charge of \$10.
 5. Entry fee is 10% of first premiums or \$7 minimum for all entries
 6. Rabbits will be judged at 3 p.m. on Friday, August 13th at the Pole Barn. Exhibitor or designee must present their animal to the judge on the show table.
 7. All rabbits must be a recognized variety and meet American Rabbit Breeders Association standard requirements.
 8. In breeds under 9 pounds mature weight, classes are Sr. Buck and Sr. Doe. Juniors are under 6 months. In breeds of rabbits where mature weight reaches 9 pounds and over, classes will be: Sr. Buck and Sr. Doe Classes 8 months and over, Intermediate Class 6 - 8 months, Jr. Buck and Jr. Doe Classes under 6 months.
 9. All livestock exhibits will be released between 7 p.m. on Sunday, August 15th and must be off the grounds by noon Monday, August 16th, unless specified differently. Due to the release time and other activities on the grounds, extra measures have been taken to insure that safety and traffic patterns are not impacted in any negative way. Exhibits leaving before the permitted time will forfeit their premium money.
- **Rabbits must be purebred. No mixed breeds allowed.**
 - **Each exhibitor is limited to 2 prizes per class.**

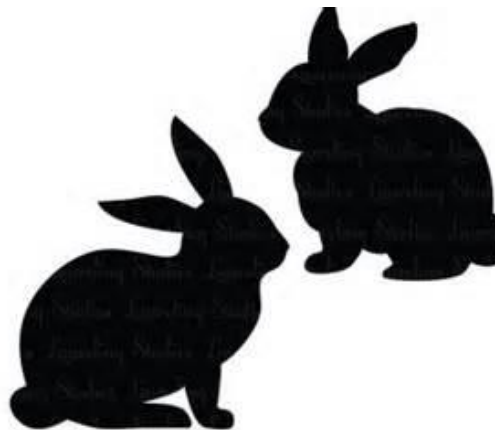

Cobleskill Agricultural Society Admission Policy for Fair Exhibitors

1. Entries must be received by July 3. Mailing/payee is Cobleskill Agricultural Society, PO Box 249, Cobleskill, NY 12043.
2. Late entries, where accepted, will be accepted thru July 10 at an additional charge \$10
3. In accordance with the bylaws of the Cobleskill Agricultural Society, Schoharie County resident exhibitors 18 years of age or older have the option to purchase a \$55 6-Day Voting Membership Pass in lieu of the \$20 6-Day Exhibitor Pass.
4. One Guardian Pass per youth exhibitor is available for an adult to accompany the youth. The price for a 6-day Guardian Pass is \$20. Not to be combined with other entry forms.

5. All entry fees will be computed and paid on this form. Entries will be made on the appropriate entry form. No premium entry fee for Dept. 11.
6. ALL open livestock exhibitors staying for the entire 6 days of the Fair are entitled to two (2) free Passes. **Exhibitors are still required to purchase tickets as required by entry.** Not to be combined with other entry forms. Tickets will not be issued unless names are provided below:

7. No tickets will be mailed. All tickets will be distributed by the Department Superintendents upon receipt (placement) of entries.
8. No exhibitor tickets, guardian pass, or free exhibitor passes will be distributed unless entered exhibits are brought to the fair.
9. Submission of an entry implies the exhibitor has read and agrees to the Fair's General Rules and Regulations and the Department's Rules and Regulation.
