

## DEPARTMENT 18 – JUNIOR DEPT: 4-H, FFA and FCCLA Exhibits

### General Rules & Regulations for Livestock & Poultry (Excluding Horses)

1. Competition is open to enrolled Schoharie County 4-H members, or FFA, or agricultural education student enrolled in a Schoharie County elementary, middle or high school during the previous school year. Youth must be at least 8 years old to exhibit in premium classes. Youth who are between 5 and 8 years old, may exhibit for participation only in classes designated as CLOVERBUD classes.
2. All exhibits in this department will be governed under the same general rules and regulations that apply to other departments.
3. Entries should be postmarked by July 6th, unless specified otherwise. The address and payee is Cobleskill Agricultural Society, PO Box 249, Cobleskill NY 12043. No fee is required to enter except for the purchase of entrance tickets.
4. No Late entries will be accepted.
5. Exhibitors 18 and under must purchase a \$5 Youth weekly exhibitor ticket. The \$5 Youth Exhibitor ticket will be issued to the exhibitor upon placement of their entry. Otherwise, exhibitors and contestants must abide by regular admission regulations - see general rules.
6. No passes will be mailed. All passes will be distributed by the Department Superintendents upon delivery of items for judging.
7. Submission of an entry implies the exhibitor has read and agrees to the Fair's General Rules and Regulations and the Department's Rules and Regulations plus all the Animal/Poultry Health Rules & Regulations.
8. Youth must be present at the time of judging. Each member is expected to be responsible for the showing and care of his or her own animal. Exceptions can be made under such circumstances or conditions as the agriculture educator may determine necessary. Up to two entries per class will be allowed. If an exhibitor has two entries in a class, the second entry must be shown by another youth who is also exhibiting in the show. Adult assistance is permitted on a case by case basis with the approval of the Cooperative Extension representative.
9. The awarding of ribbons and premiums shall be at the judge's discretion. The Danish system of awards will be used except where noted for all Junior Departments.
10. Animals/poultry cannot be put into housing until approved by Vet. Proper certificates and tags required. Drop off times are Sunday & Monday, August 4th & 5th from 9 am to 1 pm for all animals. All stalls, pens or cages must be labeled with contact person's name and best phone number.
11. All livestock exhibits will be released 7 p.m. on Sunday, August 11<sup>th</sup> and must be off the grounds before noon Monday, unless specified differently. Due to the release time and other activities on the grounds, extra measures have been taken to insure that safety and traffic patterns are not impacted in any negative way. Exhibits leaving before the permitted time will forfeit their premium money.
12. **Footwear:** Exhibitors are not permitted to wear flip flops in the animal barns. Sneakers or barn boots are strongly suggested.
13. Cloverbud Classes: Youth between the ages of 5 and 8 as of January 1 are considered Cloverbuds. Cloverbud aged youth may only enter designated Cloverbud classes for prizes and ribbons only. Cloverbuds may not enter premium classes.
14. It is expected that all Junior Department exhibitors will act in an appropriate manner. Any member of this department found conducting themselves in an improper manner or who violates any of the rules as set forth will forfeit any guarantee and premiums due and may be dismissed from the fairgrounds with exhibits. In addition, any parent displaying unsportsmanlike conduct may be subject to dismissal from the show grounds.
15. Junior Department exhibitors are urged to go home each evening. Exhibitors remaining on the fairgrounds must be chaperoned by a parent or guardian 21 or older.
16. Junior Department exhibitors remaining on the grounds overnight must be in their sleeping quarters by 11 p.m. No exhibitors may be in the barns after 11 p.m. No clipping of animals after 11 p.m.

### **JUNIOR DEPT – DAIRY**

The purpose of the Junior Department Dairy and Livestock shows are to teach the fundamentals of good livestock husbandry, to emphasize production and quality in farm animals, to stress the breeding of better livestock, to aid in developing a stronger county program, to demonstrate the finer points of fitting and showmanship, and to provide recognition and a fitting climax to each year's efforts of boys and girls.

- Competition is open to enrolled Schoharie County 4-H members or active FFA members enrolled in a Schoharie County FFA program. Youth participants must be at least 8 years of age by January 1<sup>st</sup> of current club year and not have reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to January.
- Exhibitors must adhere to Animal Health Requirements for Admission to New York State and County Fairs for the current show season. (Refer to the beginning of premium list for more information).
- Showmanship and Dairy Cattle will be shown on **Wednesday, 8/9 @ 9am.**
- No substitutions are allowed.
- All exhibitors must be in the ring for the entire class in order to receive a premium for that class. In the event that the Junior Exhibitor cannot handle his or her animal, the exhibitor must still have some control of the halter to receive a premium.
- Cattle may be registered or non-registered - must fit A. or B.
  - A. All registered animals entered must have registration papers showing ownership by the exhibitor. Registration papers should be available to present during the fair.
  - B. All grade animals must have a grade ownership certificate. Grade ownership certificates are available from the Cooperative Extension Office and must be complete with all required signatures, but are not required to be on file. However, certificates should be available to present during the fair..
- Cattle may be either owned or non-owned - must fit A. or B.
  - A. All owned cattle must be personally owned and registered to the youth exhibitor as well as cared for by that exhibitor by no later than June 1 of the current year. However, youth should be working with their project animal(s) care. Dual ownership or syndicates are not allowed.
    - \* We will check ownership paperwork

**\*NEW EXCEPTION:** Dual ownership between siblings will be allowed as long as all of the following criteria are met:

1. They are all bona fide siblings(sister, brother, step sister/brother, half sister/brother, adopted).
2. All siblings on registration paper of animal(s) are of 4-H age and regular members as of

Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Cloverbuds are not eligible. For NY State Fair entries entered through FFA or endorsed by a breed organization representative will need to follow 4-H rules on age also for the Dairy Youth Show.

3. One sibling has to designate the animal as their project animal for the project year by June 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year by filing and completing animal identification form.
  4. Completed animal identification form needs to be filed with the appropriate organization (4-H county extension, FFA or Breed organization) to state the youth designation by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
  5. Designation cannot change during the program year and animal must be shown and exhibited by designated sibling.
  6. Bred and owned recognition can be given to designated youth as long as dual ownership is a current and legal partnership filed with breed organization.
- B. All non-owned cattle must be designated in the youth exhibitor's name and cared for by that exhibitor no later than June 1 of the current year. However, youth should be working with their project animal early on in the project year and should be assuming much of the responsibility for the animal's care.

Non-ownership is not available to youth already owning registered dairy cattle. One non-ownership certificate and the non-ownership rules and guidelines, properly filled out and signed by all parties must be completed and returned by the June 1 deadline. These forms are available from the Cooperative Extension Office. A copy of the non-ownership certificate should be kept by the exhibitor and be available to present during the fair. Youth are limited to showing two non-owned animals. Dual designation of one animal is not permitted.

- Every animal must be accompanied by proper health certificates. Health requirements are the same as those for open class dairy exhibitors. Any animal disqualified for participation in the Fair should be removed from the grounds by the end of the same day.
- Bedding, hay and grain must be furnished by the exhibitor.
- All animals must be housed in the stalls designated by the Dairy Superintendent throughout the duration of the fair.
- Whites are obligatory for all youth showing for the Jr. Dept. Dairy Show on Wednesday. White pants are required for all breed classes though a farm shirt or other solid color shirt is acceptable. Appropriate footwear (preferably boots, but protective footwear is required) must be worn at all times. Flip flops should not be worn in the barn.
- **Please see Department 2, Section 7, Class 6 for Herdsmanship Class open to all youth.**
